Adorably Smitten©
Fingerless Mittens, Smitten
Scarf, or Valentine Bag



Scarf

Materials:

- 1 skein of L'Atelier's Adorably Smitten hand-tied yarn (75yds)
- U.S. Size 11 needles
- 1 Smitten Scarf Adornment (Dangle Stick or Stick Pin)

Pattern:

1. Cast on 11 stitches
2. Knit in Garter Stitch (knitting every row – no purling) until about 12" of yarn remains.
3. Bind off loosely or with larger needle.
4. Weave in Cast-On and Bind-Off tails.
5. Add Dangle Stick pin, Smitten scarf adornments to taste and enjoy or give as a gift.

Mittens or Bag (use appropriate graph)

Materials:

- Color A - One skein of L'Atelier's Adorably Smitten Hand-Tied Yarn
- Color B (for cuff edgings and heart) - One Skein of Trendsetter Kashmir or Lana Grossa Meringo, Filatura Mist, Jade Sapphire Mongolian Cashmere, or similar gauge yarn in color



complimentary to yarn. “B” Color suggestions: for Red/My Valentine use Red, for Pink/Sweetheart use darker or lighter Pink, for Hot Pink/Kiss use dark pink or fuchsia, and for Brown/Bon Bon use Brown, Red, or light Pink.

- U.S. Size 5 and size 6 Knitting Needles
- Tapestry Needle
- Optional Ribbon to lace thru eyelet stitches – For Bag

Gauge: in stockinet stitch and size 6 needles – 4½ stitches across to the inch

Pattern:

Note: The Heart Pattern is optional and knit into only one of the Mittens/Gauntlets. The second Gauntlet is solid. Wear the heart on top of the hand or turn around and wear in the palm of the hand. Also, when knitting the heart, if your hand-tied yarn sequence in that section is too similar to your “Heart Yarn”, cut out the too-similar color and re-knot with a more contrasting color. This will create a more attractive, distinctive heart shape.

Picot Eyelet Edging.

With B and size 5 needles, work picot as follows:

1. *Cast on 5 stitches using the cable cast on method, BO 2sts, slip st on right needle back to left needle. Repeat from * until (30, 33), 36 stitches total.
2. Rows 1-5 knit every row.
3. Row 6 (WS) P1, *yo, p2tog, repeat from * to end. (Size *small or large* – Purl the last stitch.)
4. Row 7-9 knit every row.
5. Row 10 (WS) – if making size *medium*, knit to last two stitches and K2TOG (To get an even number of stitches – 32 remaining). For size *large*, knit 1st two stitches together and last two stitches together for a total of 34 stitches remaining on needle. For size *small*, continue with the 30 stitches.
6. Change to A, begin with knit row, work 2 rows in st st. [for Bag pattern, change to size 6 needle.]
7. Work in k2, p2 rib stitch for (1 ½”, 1 ¾”), 2”. Not a critical measurement - this is the length covering the wrist. Tip: note all of your measurements as you will be knitting a second mitten.
8. Continuing in A, change to Size 6 needle and work in St St for (2”, 2 ½”), 3” – **If knitting the heart**, follow heart pattern graph at this time. On piece with heart, when finished with graph, purl back then continue per directions. **For mitten Heart** – work in stockinet for (2, 2,) 4 rows then begin small graph below. When finished with graph continue knitting until stockinet section is desired length as listed above. End on knit row. **For Bag heart**, work 2 rows in stockinet then follow large heart graph below. After graph, continue in Stockinet until stockinet stitch section measures 3” in length. End on knit row.
9. Change to B and size 5 needles, K 1 row.
10. (WS) P1, *y/o, p2tog: repeat from * to end, purl last stitch if one remains.
11. Work 4 rows in garter st.
